

STUDENT CONDUCT ON SCHOOL BUSES

Bus drivers are responsible for maintaining discipline and proper behavior among students riding the bus, unless a teacher is there for that purpose, or if the teacher does not exercise proper control. A driver should not administer corporal punishment to a student. Any serious matter should be referred to the administration.

No student may be put off a school bus while enroute.

After due warning has been given to the student and to his parents, the superintendent may withhold from the student the privilege of riding the school bus. The student also may be denied admission to school, suspended or expelled, in accordance with established policies, for flagrant violation of school bus rider conduct regulations or conduct detrimental to the safe operation of the bus.
