PROGRAMS FOR HANDICAPPED STUDENTS

In keeping with the intention of the State of Colorado to offer educational opportunities to all children which will enable them to lead fulfilling and productive lives, the district shall provide appropriate educational opportunities to all resident children, in accordance with the requirements of State and Federal statutes.

The East Central Colorado Board of Cooperative Services has been designated as the educational agency to provide activities and services for meeting the special education needs of handicapped students.

The Arickaree Board of Education has the final determination on placement of children in these programs.
