EXTENDED INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS

The Board of Education will allow credit for correspondence courses taken under the following criteria:

- 1. Only junior and senior students will be eligible to apply for correspondence courses.
- 2. The correspondence course must be a course not offered in the Arickaree School curriculum.
- 3. The course must be approved by the counselor, administrator and Board of Education prior to enrollment.
- 4. The student will pay for tuition, books and any other supplies and materials. Upon satisfactory completion of the course, the Board of Education will refund the cost of the tuition only, and will honor the grade received.
- 5. The course must be completed prior to the end of the school year in which the course was approved, unless extended by the Board of Education
- 6. The student must have a member of the Arickaree faculty as a local advisor.
- 7. The student must carry a full load of seven units of credit.
