

INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS

As the governing body of the school district, the Board is legally responsible for the selection of instructional materials. Since the Board is a policy making body, it delegates to professional personnel of the district the authority for the selection of instructional and library materials in accordance with the policy below.

Materials for school classrooms and school libraries shall be selected by the appropriate professional personnel in consultation with the administration and faculty. Final decision on purchase shall rest with the Superintendent or his designee, subject to adoption by the Board.
