Athletic Director's Report:

Kicked off basketball season with Las Animas, Genoa Hugo Thursday, Saturday Flat Iron. Paul Griese retired from coaching next season. Shot clock update: Varsity will be required to use it. It will cost \$5,000.00-6,000.00 to upgrade circuit board for our current system by 2026. Legislative council proposal for this to be 4A and above due to the financial burden and hardship. Shot clock discussion,

looking into options. Garretson, no installation – may cost \$2,000.00 to set up electrical. Sports Coop Board meeting November 14. Adding a second assistant coach for HS teams. Transportation: for practices, we are switching back and forth – Darla Brady is doing the late trips after bus route. Missey is asked to speak to coaches that at Arickaree practice ends at 6:00 – so that the bus coming back from Woodlin isn't late. Missey was asked to send the MOU for the Sports Coop to the Board. Next year game schedule will be a 50/50 split. For the next cycle, we need to reup and take some time to come up with a name, mascot and colors. There is also a possibility of adding the track program to the coop. Justin at CHSAA – Track, ½ entries of all other divisions, more 1A in track than all other school divisions. Sports fee to offset costs, maximum per family/kids. Different rate for homeschoolers? Golf added to coop? Kids liked it and it is a lifetime sport. Uniform situation – basketball kids got theirs last week.

Maintenance Report:

Standard meeting lately. Lifts, used ones United Rental Sales - \$4-6,000.00. December 18th at 1:00 p.m. we will have a demo of Tiny mobile robot to paint the field. Can do extra stuff on computer: \$25,000.00 to own the machine. Looking to go in on it with other area schools. Otis/Briggsdale like it and potential to use ½ of the paint over a year. Pro or sport model packages are offered at different costs. Woodlin coming over to watch. Board is invited to come see. Flagler may share, Hi-Plains possible. Company's in Denver to paint field. What would update cost for program? Keep lines on field through the season.

Board asked: Water engineer guy come? Yes, mid-October. Dannie coming Friday to work on system and will give us updates.

Board asked: Handle for the front door? Friday Standard Glass came for measurements.

Fire inspector said the west door of gym was not up to code. Leak 2 weeks ago, possibly coming off the roof. Drips by the 3rd grade room. Kindergarten/1st grade rooms – Dustin came out took the panels off, snow so deep it went in the vents above.

Board asked: Did you go check the roof?

Superintendent's Report-

Gena Ramey, Shonda King and Patricia Champ have done a great job mentoring the elementary teachers. They will step back a little and will be available. Several meetings to help with confidence. Para's subs- this semester have been a lot of help. Teacher Inservice for February 7th will be January 31st. Centennial Mental Health coming out. Digital citizenship – good positive behavior now needs to do it. Ice machine broke. Last year it was repaired, now not good. Sam's club has some and will check

on how much and number of pounds of ice produced. Sam's will deliver. Free standing one is what we are looking at. Christmas program is December 11th at 7:00 p.m. Piano on stage needs new coasters. December 19th Board will come to hand out Christmas Cards with bonus.
